<p><b>Accommodation</b></p>	<p>We can provide some rooms in our EIGSI residence.</p> <p>Students have to write an email to <a href="mailto:mobility@eigsi.fr">mobility@eigsi.fr</a> as soon as they are accepted to apply. The number of rooms is very limited.</p> <p>EIGSI will also provide a list of external housing and useful addresses.</p>
<p><b>VISA</b></p>	<p><b><u>European students</u></b></p> <p>Students from a country within the European Union <b>do not need a visa</b> but must have a valid identity card or passport.</p> <p><b><u>Non-European students</u></b></p> <p>International students from a country outside of the European Union <b>must have a long stay visa</b> to live in France during one semester.</p> <p>Students must undergo the visa process through the website: <a href="http://france-visas.gouv.fr">france-visas.gouv.fr</a> and Campus France. Once the visa is received, students will be able to travel to La Rochelle. It is usually valid for a year.</p> <p>Immediately upon arrival at EIGSI, students will carry out procedures required by the government, pay the tax online (50€) and validate their Long Stay Visa. After payment, the visa will be valid. A certificate will be sent by email. Students must keep this document carefully, it will be necessary for other procedures.</p>
<p><b>Estimated cost of living</b></p>	<p>The budget of a student living in La Rochelle is around 900€ per month.</p> <p>Average monthly rent for a studio : 550€  Food (univ restaurant's meal price: 3,25€) : 250€  Insurance (rent, liability, healthcare) : 50€  Daily expenses (telephone, laundry, entertainment) : 100€</p>
